

APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP AND ELECTRIC SERVICE

The undersigned (hereinafter called the "applicant", hereby applies for membership in, and agrees to purchase electric energy from SPRINGER ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC. (hereinafter called the "Cooperative"), upon the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The Applicant will pay to the Cooperative the sum of \$5.00 which, if this application is accepted by the Cooperative, will constitute the Applicant's membership fee. (Not applicable if consumer is already a member.) **Also Required:** A \$_____ deposit or letter of credit from a current utility. **NOTE:** If Applicant has a bad credit rating with the Cooperative from a past account, Applicant will be required to pay the deposit and a letter of credit will not be accepted.
- 2. The Applicant will, when electric energy becomes available, purchase from the Cooperative all, **except to the extent that the Applicant is generating its own power**, electric energy used on the premises described below and will pay therefore monthly, at rates to be determined from time to time in accordance with the by-laws of the Cooperative; provided, however, that the Cooperative may limit the amount of electric energy to be furnished for industrial uses. The applicant will pay a bill of at least \$_____ per _____ regardless of the number of kilowatt hours consumed, plus amounts stated below, if applicable.

ELECTRIC SERVICE HEREUNDER REQUIRES THAT NEW FACILITIES BE CONSTRUCTED TO PROVIDE ELECTRIC SERVICE TO THIS LOCATION AND IS SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE COOPERATIVE'S EXTENSION POLICY AS CHECKED BELOW:

- 1. The Applicant will cause his premises to be wired in accordance with wiring specifications approved by the Cooperative and the State Electrical Board.
- 2. The Applicant will comply with and be bound by the provisions of the certificate of incorporation and by-laws of the Cooperative, and such rules and regulations as may from time to time be adopted by the Cooperative.
- 3. The Applicant by paying a membership fee and becoming a member, assumes no personal liability or responsibility for any debts or liabilities of the Cooperative, and it is expressly understood that under the law his private property cannot be attached for such debts and liabilities.

- A. Line Extension To Permanent Facility**
— The Consumer agrees to pay a cash contribution in aid of construction that exceeds the Cooperative's established maximum investment as stated in the Cooperative's established rules as filed with the Public Regulation Commission. A copy of which may be obtained from the Cooperative's office.
- B. Line Extension To Temporary Facilities Or Stock Wells.**
— The Consumer agrees to pay full cost of construction. Where Consumer pays full cost of construction there is no requirement to receive service for a specified term.
- C. Line Extension to Mobile Homes.**
— The Consumer agrees to pay full cost of construction, unless the following requirements for a permanent foundation are met:
 - 1. Removal of axles.
 - 2. Removal of tongue.
 - 3. Cement pads for blocking.

THE ACCEPTANCE OF THIS APPLICATION FOR LINE EXTENSION SHALL CONSTITUTE A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE APPLICANT AND THE COOPERATIVE, AND SHALL CONTINUE IN FORCE FOR AT LEAST _____ FROM THE DATE SERVICE IS MADE AVAILABLE BY THE COOPERATIVE TO THE APPLICANT.
